Betty and I will miss you all this year but we will be back next year, 2023. We are already signed up for 2023 so to get the all the extra benefits. Get it?

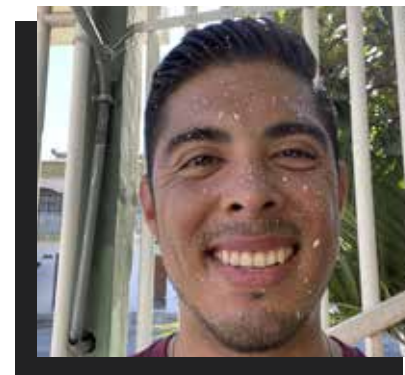
Since we cannot hang out with you on and off ship I have sent my friend Carmen to represent me from CYE.

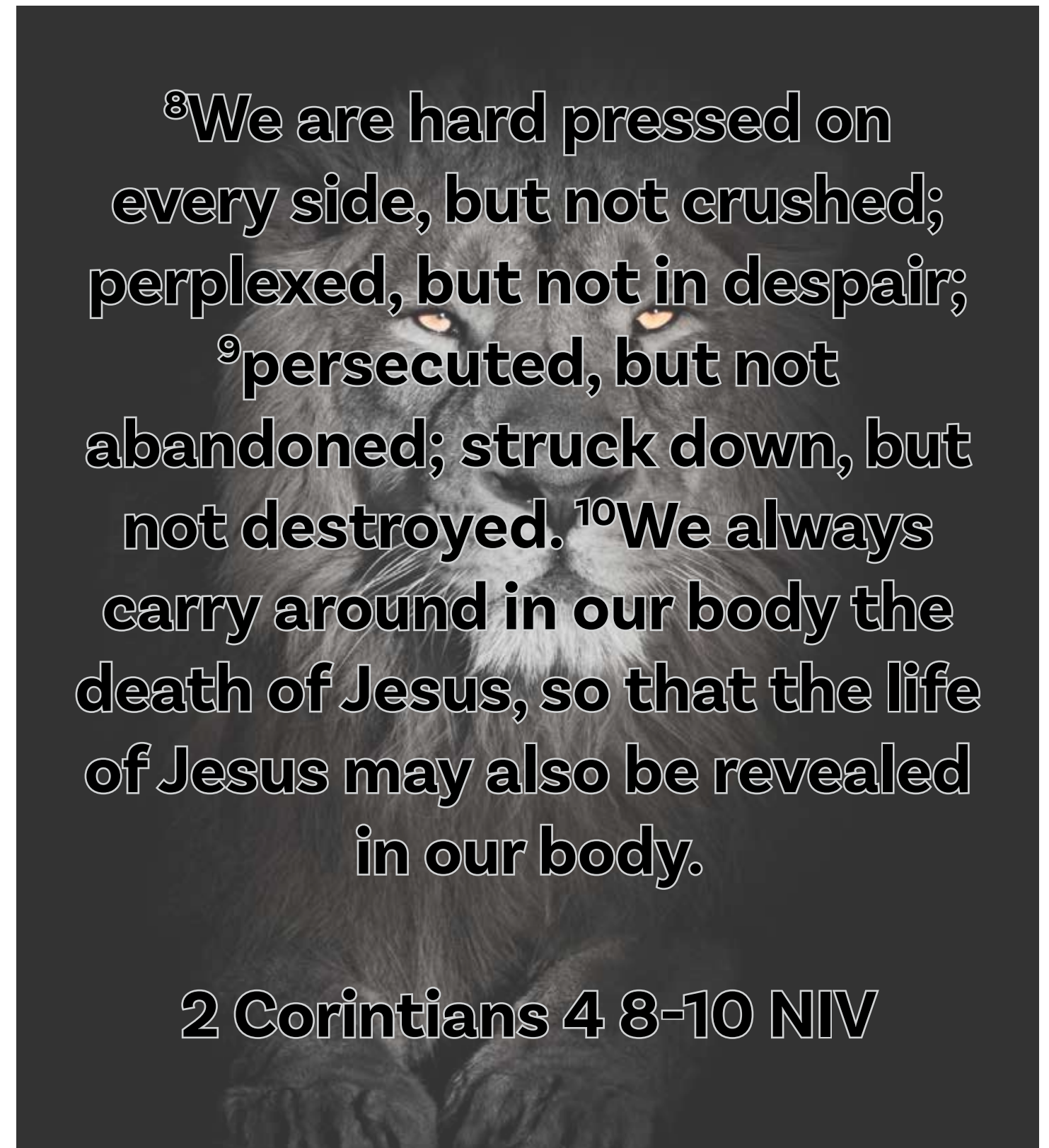
MEET
